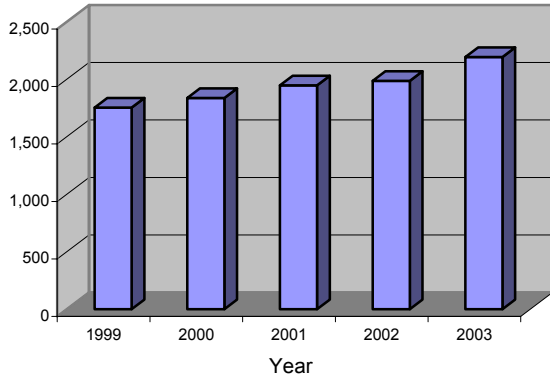

Number of Beginning Freshmen

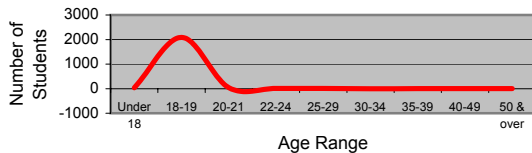

Age of Beginning Freshmen



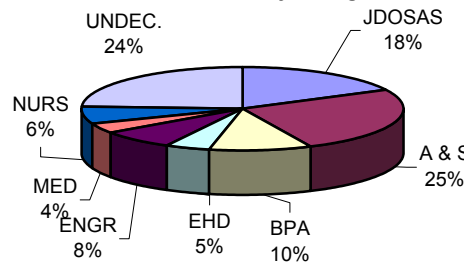
