

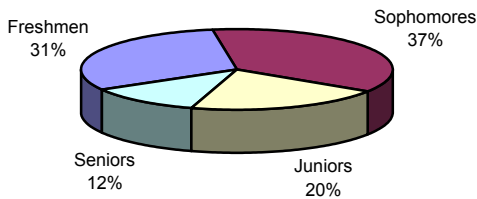

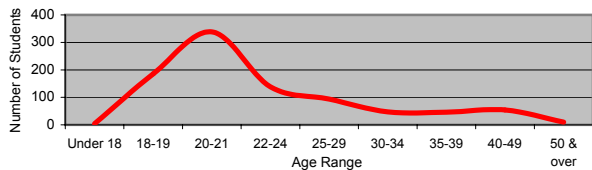

Age of New Transfers

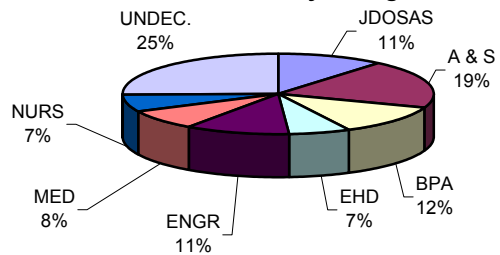
