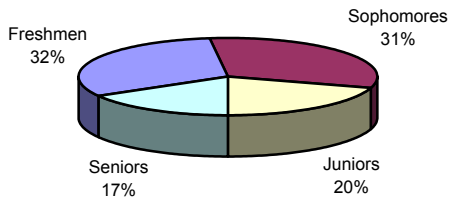

New Transfers by Classification

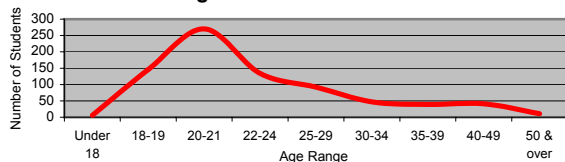

Age of New Transfers



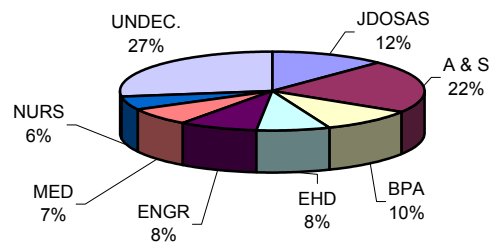
