

Financial Aid Timeline

May—July, 2009

Financial Aid Award Notices for 2009-2010 are sent on an ongoing basis to eligible students with completed FAFSAs. The award notice must be processed electronically on *CampusConnection* and submitted to the Student Financial Aid Office within 30 days.

New borrowers must complete Entrance Loan Counseling at www.financialaid.und.edu.

Begin application process for PLUS loans or other alternative loans.

June 1-July 10: New Freshman Getting Started Program

Make sure your financial aid file for the next award year is complete. Outstanding issues with your financial aid file after August 1 may cause delays in the disbursement of your fall semester funds.

August, 2009

Fall Semester charges are available on *CampusConnection*.

Federal Stafford Loan applications are processed by your lender and guarantee agency. A Notice of Loan Guarantee and Disclosure Statement will be sent to you by your lender. Sign a Master Promissory Note if requested by your lender or Student Account Services.

Financial Information

Check out the balance you have due to the University and the status of your financial aid through *CampusConnection*. A link to *CampusConnection* is at www.und.edu. You will need to know your student ID number to log in. Balances due are available beginning approximately one month before the start of each semester.

- Your Account Summary may change throughout the semester. You should plan to check this regularly on *CampusConnection*. Student Account Services will not mail out paper billing statements.

Buying Books—Students may charge textbooks and school supplies at the University Bookstore using their Student ID Card. The charging period runs for approximately one week each semester, starting the Friday before classes begin.

Tuition and Fee Payment—You are expected to pay the total charges for one semester by the third week of classes each semester or a late penalty will be assessed. For Fall Semester, this is September 11, 2009. **Students who have not paid tuition and fees by September 11, 2009, are subject to cancellation.**

Deferment—You are responsible for payment of tuition and fees in excess of your anticipated financial aid. If you are unable to pay tuition/fees in full by the due date, you may be eligible for a tuition/fee payment deferment. Contact the Student Financial Aid Office for more information.

Financial aid disbursement begins after of the second week of classes each semester. Financial aid in excess of your bill will be available at the beginning of the third week.

- Financial aid will be disbursed based on the number of credit hours you are enrolled in as of **11:59pm September 2** for fall 2009 and **11:59pm January 21** for spring 2010. **Classes dropped or added after this date will not be considered for financial aid eligibility.**
- Part-term classes dropped before their start date may result in the repayment of financial aid received or the reduction of aid awarded.
- Financial aid in excess of your bill will be sent to your **UND Pride Card**. Go to www.UNDPrideCard.com to set up direct-deposit of refunds to your personal bank account or to authorize deposit into the bank account associated with your Pride Card.

Loan Disbursement:

- The scheduled bank disbursement date can be found on the Disclosure Statement, which will be sent to you by your lender after the loan has been processed by UND, but no earlier than mid-August. The scheduled bank disbursement date is when the lender will send the funds to UND. Loan funds will be disbursed to your University account no earlier than the scheduled Financial Aid Disbursement date for each semester.
- Your lender will send loan funds to the University by either Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) and the funds will credit your account automatically. This disbursement information will appear on Account Summary in *CampusConnection*.
