### EAGAN MINNESOTA NATIVE BRINGS VISUAL COMMUNICATION SKILLS TO AWARD-WINNING TELEVISION SHOW Carter Cusack interns as a photographer with *Studio One*

**GRAND FORKS, N.D.** — Eagan, Minn. native Carter Cusack, is interning as a photographer with *Studio One*, an award-winning television show produced at the University of North Dakota. This is his second semester as a photographer with the program. Last semester Cusack was a camera operator during the live production. He says the best part his internship experience is working with the people, “[The staff and students] I work with along with meeting people while on shoots [are great]. All of them are incredibly nice and interesting.” Last semester, he was awarded the *Studio One* Recognition of Excellence for his creative contributions to the program.

In addition to his internship, Cusack is involved with the German Table at UND. He has also received the Max Karde and Boswau Award. The Boswau Award is a bursary that assisted him in studying abroad in Berlin.
