In his first semester with the program, Gendreau operates a camera on show days and works as a feature reporter. As a reporter, he conducts interviews, shoots footage and edits video. He says he is developing skills at *Studio One* that will help him in the future. “*Studio One* has given me the experience to begin a career in media,” he adds. “I now know how to report, edit and work with a camera...[*Studio One*] is a fun yet professional approach to learning,” he explains.
