Unrau is currently interning as the co-anchor for the live television show. This position requires her to research and conduct live television interviews, all while adhering to professional guidelines. She also has received several awards from the North Dakota Professional Communicators. She won first place for her interview on cranial helmets. She also received honorable mention for a feature reporting story highlighting the day-in-the-life of a bus boy. She says that “*Studio One* has put me above my peers and job competition because all of the real-life experience.”

Unrau’s accomplishments expand beyond *Studio One*, she won the Grand Forks Herald Scholarship last spring. She is also the Vice President of Membership for the UND Chapter of Toastmasters International.
