1. Describe some aspects of this course that promoted your learning.

  - We paid \$140.00 for books but did not use the data analysis book much, the CD is worthless in that book
  - Students who expect to pursue the MSW degree might be redirected to the lengthier, more in depth, full term course rather than summer (short) course.
  - Getting information to blackboard more timely
  - As much as I despised excel assignments it was actually good practice and learning skills
  - I would suggest making it clear that students should take notes during the instruction on excel. The book was difficult to understand
