

## Call for Proposals – Student Technology Fee Spring 2010 (AY103)

Presently the University community is working toward the establishment of Core Technology Services meant to provide a set of robust, efficient and effective IT services to all user groups. In support of this effort and the resulting changes to existing governance structures, the distribution of FY10 Student Technology Fee funding is being handled in a way that is consistent with examination of potential core technology services.

Student Technology Fee funding will continue to be used for projects in instructional programs and solely for the benefit of UND students. Spring 2010 (FY103) Student Technology Fee proposals should not include projects that fall within the following Core Technology Service areas unless the funding is necessary to maintain or repair existing hardware, software, equipment or facilities. The University Chief Information Officer will determine whether or not a funding request is outside of the aforementioned scope. All appropriate funding requests will be given to the Provost or President for consideration.

Questions regarding the Spring 2010 (FY103) Student Technology Fee should be directed to the University Chief Information Officer.

15. Smart and Technology Enhanced Classrooms
16. Computer Replacement Cycle (purchase or lease)
