Research Grant Application Guidelines

Criteria for Awarding Grants:

A. Applicant Criteria

**Formal preparation in the conduct of nursing research
Baccalaureate or higher degree in nursing or nursing student enrolled in a
higher degree program in nursing with direct supervision of a qualified
teacher meeting above criteria (Applicant should submit supervisor's C.V.)**

B. Application - Submit the following:

- 1. Application**
- 2. A written research proposal according to the guidelines (Data collection may be in process.).**
- 3. A signed formal agreement for money usage and public report findings.**

C. Preference will be given to Sigma Theta Tau members, other attributes being equal (No member of the awards, scholarship, research committees or Board of Directors is eligible for funding while in office.).

D. Competitive Basis for Fund Allocation

- 1. Quality of written proposal**
- 2. Contribution of the research proposed to nursing science and public benefit**
- 3. Research proposal budget**
- 4. Research fund budget and number of proposals submitted**

E. The maximum amount to be awarded each applicant is \$1000.00.

F. The grants are awarded once a year. The deadline for application is April 1, 2006.
