## Staff Senate Scholarship

### The Recipient Must:

- Be a dependent child (natural, adoptive, foster, or step-child) of a benefited staff member who has been employed by UND for a minimum of one year at the time of the application deadline;
- Dependent shall be defined according to the U.S. Department of Education Financial Aid Student Guide. A student is dependent only if he/she can answer “no” to all of the following:
  - *I am 24 years or older as of January 1 the year of application;*
  - *I am married;*
  - *I am enrolled in a graduate or professional (law or medical school) program;*
  - *I have legal dependents other than a spouse;*
  - *I am (or was until age 18) an orphan or ward of the court;*
  - *I am a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces (“veteran” includes a student who attended a U.S. military academy who was released under a condition other than dishonorable).*
- Be an admitted undergraduate student to UND;
- Be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours per semester);
- Have a minimum of 2.0 GPA for college credits or be eligible for admission to UND if currently a high school senior.

For the 2011-2012 academic year, the award will be:

- **\$250/semester for a maximum of two semesters**

A minimum of 10 recipients will be selected randomly from a pool of eligible applicants.

This scholarship can be received in addition to any other scholarship award.

Students must reapply each year.
